

## Women's History Network - Community History Prize sponsored by the History Press

**This annual prize of £500 is awarded for a Community History Project by, about, or for Women in a particular locale or community** which has led to the production of a documentary, pamphlet, book, exhibition, artefact or event completed between the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2014 and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2015.

Individuals or groups can nominate themselves or someone else up to the 31 May 2015.
